**Samdech Akka Moha Sena Padei Techo HUN SEN**, Prime Minister of the Kingdom of Cambodia, will lead a high-level delegation to attend the 6<sup>th</sup> Greater Mekong Sub-region (6<sup>th</sup> GMS) Summit back-to-back with the 10<sup>th</sup> Cambodia-Laos-Viet Nam Summit on Development Triangle Area (10<sup>th</sup> CLV-DTA), from 30 to 31 March 2018, in Hanoi, Viet Nam, at the invitation of His Excellency **Nguyen Xuan Phuc**, Prime Minister of the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam.

The Cambodian dignitaries to accompany **Samdech Techo Prime Minister** will include, His Excellency **Aun Pornmoniroth**, Senior Minister, Minister of Economy and Finance, His Excellency **Sun Chanthol**, Senior Minister, Minister of Public Works and Transport, His Excellency **Var Kimhong**, Senior Minister, Chairman of the National Border Committee, His Excellency **Pan Sorasak**, Minister of Commerce, His Excellency **Thong Khon**, Minister of Tourism, His Excellency Dr. **Hang Chuon Naron**, Minister of Education, Youth and Sports, His Excellency **Veng Sakhon**, Minister of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries, as well as other members of the Royal Government of Cambodia.

During the 6<sup>th</sup> GMS Summit that will be held with the theme “Leveraging on 25 Years of Cooperation, and Building a Sustainable, Integrated, and Prosperous GMS”, the Leaders will formally adopt the Hanoi Action Plan 2018-2022 and the Regional Investment Framework 2022. A Joint Summit Declaration will also be issued.

In the framework of the 6<sup>th</sup> GMS Summit, Samdech Techo will also make an address at the GMS Business Summit, focusing on the successes and challenges in the development of the Mekong sub-region.

During the 10<sup>th</sup> CLV-DTA, the Leaders will review the past achievements of the initiative and set vision for its future development in key areas, including cooperation in economy, trade, investment, infrastructure and energy. The Leaders will adopt the Plan of Action for Cambodia-Laos-Viet Nam economic connectivity up to 2030 and sign a Joint Declaration of the 10<sup>th</sup> CLV-DTA.

The participation of **Samdech Techo Prime Minister** at these two events will reflect Cambodia’s commitment to promote friendship and cooperation within the GMS and the CLV frameworks in order to ensure peace, stability and sustainable development in the region.
