

REPORT IN BRIEF AS OF JUNE 20th 2013

The World Heritage Committee has examined the state of conservation of 38 properties inscribed on the List of World Heritage in Danger (WHC-13/37.COM/7A), excepting " Old City of Jerusalem and its Wall", Jordan and of 102 properties on the World Heritage List (WHC-13/37.COM/7B) in 4 consecutive days from June 17 to June 20, 2014.

I. WORLD HERITAGE PROPERTIES ON THE LIST IN DANGER (WHC-13/37.COM/7A)

Among 38 World Heritage sites on the List of World Heritage in Danger, there was only one cultural site in Asia and Pacific, **Bam and its Cultural Landscape of Iran**, was removed from the List in Danger by the World Heritage Committee and the remaining are still on the World Heritage List.

II. WORLD HERITAGE PROPERTIES ON THE WORLD HERITAGE LIST (WHC-13/37.COM/7A)

Among 102 World Heritage sites on the World Heritage List, 5 sites were proposed by the Advisory Bodies and World Heritage Center to inscribe on the List of World Heritage in Danger. However, the Committee has decided to inscribe only 2 World Heritage sites on the List in Danger, **East Rennell** of Solomon Islands, and World Heritage properties of Syria, consisting of **Ancient City of Damascus** , **Ancient City of Bosra** , **Site of Palmyra**,

Ancient City of Aleppo, Crac des Chevaliers and Qal'at Saalah El-Din and Ancient Villages of Northern Syria. The Committee is considering the Archaeological Site of Panama Viejo and Historic District of Panama, Panama and it, till now, still not decided yet.
