His Excellency Prak Sokhonn, Senior Minister, Minister of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation of Cambodia will lead a delegation to attend the 72nd Session of the United Nations General Assembly and other important meetings to be held in New York from 19 to 25 September 2017.

H.E. Senior Minister Prak Sokhonn will deliver his statement at the 72nd Session of the UNGA focusing on the importance of the collective effort to address climate change and terrorism, Cambodia's achievement on Millennium Development Goals (MDGs) and Cambodia's efforts towards the Sustainable Development Goals. Regional and international issues of common concerns and the latest developments in Cambodia will be also highlighted in the statement.

The Cambodian delegation will also join the ministerial meetings under the frameworks of the Francophone, the Non-Aligned Movement (NAM), the Conference on Interaction and Confidence Building Measures in Asia (CICA), the Asia Cooperation Dialogue (ACD), G-77, the Least Developed Countries (LDCs), the Informal ASEAN Ministerial Meeting, and the ASEAN Foreign Ministers' meetings with the President of the General Assembly and the United Nations Secretary-General.

At the sideline of the General Assembly, H.E. Senior Minister Prak Sokhonn will hold bilateral meetings with his counterparts from the Cuba, Colombia, Brazil, the UK, the US and other dignitaries.

His Excellency Senior Minister and his counterparts will also sign the two following documents:

- 1.) Technical Cooperation Agreement between the Royal Government of Cambodia and the Government of the Federative Republic of Brazil, and
- 2.) Agreement between the Royal Government of Cambodia and the Government of the Republic of Colombia on the exemption of Visa for Holders of Diplomatic and Service/Official Passports.✍
